PROOF THAT COVID-19 VACCINE PROVIDES PROTECTION



Professor Glenda Gray (CEO of the South African Medical Research Council) recently provided evidence that the COVID-19 vaccine is effective in reducing new infections and hospital

Illustrated in the graphs below, Dr Gray found that the United Kingdom (UK) who experienced a second wave in November 2020, recorded around **58 000** daily new infections and around 29 000 weekly hospital admissions.

The UK started vaccinations in January this year and around 70% of their population has been vaccinated.



The UK is currently in their third wave and at around 5 July, they recorded 25 000 new daily infections and only 1750 weekly hospital admissions.

This indicates that daily infections are 57% LOWER than the previous wave, while hospital admissions DECREASED with 94% - compared to the previous wave.

It is therefore evident that vaccinations has a dramatic impact on the health of the population and it's in the best interest of all people to get vaccinated.

The UK and US currently has no preventative measures in place, no masks, no sanitization of hands and no social distancing. Simply because hospital admissions and deaths are not a risk anymore.
