It is strongly recommended that all members get vaccinated against flu as a precautionary measure.

Whilst the flu vaccine will not prevent members from getting COVID-19 (coronavirus), it is expected to reduce the probability of becoming critically ill should COVID-19 be contracted. Prevention of flu will also make healthcare resources available for the care of COVID-19 patients.

Platinum Health has made flu vaccines available at all its pharmacies and is partnering with employer groups in rolling out Flu Vaccination campaigns at selected places of work.

Who should receive a flu vaccine in particular?

- HIV, Diabetic and Hypertensive patients.
- All patients with other chronic diseases who should always be taking their chronic medication!
- The very young...6 months to two years of age.
- The older generation >50 years and especially the elderly >70 years of age.

Where to obtain the flu vaccine

- PlatComprehensive and PlatCap members can obtain annual flu vaccines from either Platinum Health in-house or designated service provider (DSP) pharmacies via the pharmacist advised therapy (PAT) option (as long as the annual limit hasn't been reached).
- Members on the PlatFreedom option can utilise their Pharmacy of Choice to obtain the flu vaccine via their PAT benefit, as long as the annual limit hasn't been reached.
- Members need to visit the respective provider pharmacies and request that the flu vaccine be dispensed on the abovementioned scheme option.
