Fifth Covid-19 Wave LESS SEVERE due to VACCINATIONS



South Africa is moving out of the Fifth Covid-19 wave and Platinum Health (PH) is grateful that the Fifth wave has proven to be less severe compared to the previous waves. The table below indicates the marked decrease in members being hospitalised and dying (as a direct result of Covid-19 symptoms) during the Fifth Covid-19 wave, compared to the previous waves. This can be attributed to members being vaccinated, having been exposed to the virus (thus gaining natural immunity), or a combination of both.
