- Principal member's identification document.

 - (A Hospital Confirmation/Notification document can temporarily be submitted, however; this document is only valid for 30 days. Therefore; you need to submit a copy of the registered birth certificate to the scheme, as soon as your baby is registered with the Department of Health.)
- If your baby's surname differs from the principal member's surname, you also need to submit an affidavit stating the reason.
- The principal member has to complete and sign a Platinum Health Membership Application form. You can download the Membership Application form from the Platinum Health website (www.platinumhealth.co.za) or it will be given to you when you visit any of the places mentioned above.
