SCHEME RULE CHANGES

The PH BOT has approved the amendments to rule 18 of the Main rules, which deals with composition of the board. The BOT considered the new developments and the expansion of the scheme a number of new participating employers. In view of these developments, the PH BOT recommends the rule 18 amendments to be accepted by members in a Special General Meeting in terms of **Rule 32.2.2**. The new rule 18 amendments are as follows:

18. GOVERNANCE

- 18.1 The affairs of the Scheme must be managed according to these rules by a Board consisting of sixteen persons who are fit and proper to be Trustees.
- 18.2 The board members shall elect the Chairperson from amongst the two independent members. The board shall be made up of eight employer nominated Trustees and eight member elected Trustees. Each Trustee shall have an alternate who, if, the Trustee is unable to attend a board meeting, may be requested to attend on trustee's behalf.
 - 18.2.1 The elected member Trustees shall represent members in the following constituencies namely:

<u>Constituency 1</u> comprising members employed at Anglo American Platinum - Process Division Operations and Northam Eland and other operations in the surrounding area;

<u>Constituency 2</u> comprising members employed at Siyanda Bakgatla Platinum operations and other operations in the Union mine area;

<u>Constituency 3</u> comprising members employed at Anglo American Platinum operations and other operations in the Tumela and Dishaba Mines area;

<u>Constituency 4</u> comprising members employed at the Royal Bafokeng Platinum operations and such other operations in the surrounding area as agreed from time to time;

<u>Constituency 5</u> comprising members employed at the Modikwa Platinum operations, Two Rivers Platinum operations, Booysendal Platinum operations, Mototolo Platinum operations, Dwarsrivier Platinum operations, Der Brochen Platinum operations and such other operations in the surrounding area as agreed from time to time;

<u>Constituency 6</u> comprising of members employed at Corporate Offices (this would include all Participating Employer corporate offices), Platinum Health Medical Scheme and Retirees;

<u>Constituency 7</u> comprising members employed at the Northam Platinum Zondereinde operations and such other operations in the surrounding area as agreed from time to time;

<u>Constituency 8</u> comprising members employed at the Bokoni Platinum operations and Mogalakwena Platinum operations, Twickenham Platinum operations and such other operations in the surrounding area as agreed from time to time.

18.2.2

a. The employer, employing the majority of members in a particular constituency may be entitled to nominate such employer nominated Trustees and alternates to the board, provided that the employer employing the majority of members in Constituency 6 and Constituency 8 must appoint independent Trustees as nominated by

the Remuneration Committee (REMCO) of Platinum Health Medical Scheme.

- b. In the event one participating employer has the majority of members in both Constituencies 6 and 8, such an employer shall forgo the entitlement to appoint an independent Trustee in one of the constituencies to the second participating employer that has majority of members in the constituency where the entitlement has been forgone.
- c. In the event that the employer has or creates its own dedicated" inhouse" medical scheme, notwithstanding employees remaining on the scheme, the employer will not be entitled to nominate such employer nominated trustee and alternate to the Board as set out in (a) above.
- d. In the event that the rule set in (b) above applies to the employer, a suitable experienced and competent independent employer nominated Trustee will be identified after due diligent search and such nomination will be placed by REMCO of Platinum Health Medical Scheme before employer nominated Trustees who may accept such nomination.
- e. At least one employer nominated trustee has to have appropriate financial expertise. Furthermore, it would be advantageous for employers to ensure legal, medical and HR expertise amongst the Trustees nominated.
